Rules of Golf

Would all members please be aware of the changes in the Rules of Golf effective from 01 January 2019. Copies of the players handbook detailing these changes are available in the Clubhouse and the Bothy. In addition to these rules, the club has introduced local rules to cover unmarked areas of Ground Under Repair (GUR) allowing players a free drop under Rule 20 -2 of the Rules of Golf.

Local Rule – Areas of Relief

1st Hole - the piles of soil which contain loose boulders/stones left of the first green.

9th, 11th, 15th & 16th Holes – piles of grass cuttings left by the green keepers on the left hand side of the 9th, beyond the green at the 11th, beyond the green at the 15th and behind the green at the 16th.

11th, 16th & 17th Holes - tree branches gathered by the green keepers and left piled up in the wooded area's on the right hand side of the 11th fairway, and between the 16th and 17th fairways and behind the 16th green.

5th, 10th & 17th Holes- uprooted trees at the foot of Spion Kop between the 5th & 9th fairway, up from 10th tee between the 10th and 11th fairway and on the left of the 17th green beside the path

Any balls coming to rest in any of these Area's are allowed a free drop subject to Rule 20-2. These local rules come into effect immediately.
